SUBJ: Monthly Report, February 2018

1. Membership: The 2nd Quarter National Rosters were posted in late January and reviewed in detail this month. The department membership remained steady at 4,145 members, down only 3 members from last quarter. Our 51 detachments dropped one to 50 detachments when we retrieved the charter of a detachment. Our delinquency rate improved from 67% to 48%, still unacceptable though heading in the right direction. A one page document is being prepared to provide a snapshot of all detachments and their standings for review by officers of the department. Only two detachments have reached the Commandant's goal of less than 10%: Gator Det# 990 (8%), Bill Hughes Leatherneck Det 1240 (5%), and North Post Det 948 (10%). Kudos!! At the other end of the spectrum, there are four detachments at 100% delinquency. Here is plenty of work to do.

2. Fund Raiser:

a. Winchester 30/30: Raffle tickets have been made and are set for disbursement to detachments the first week in March to reach as many members in the department, especially to the 95% who do not attend conferences or our annual convention. Tickets will still be on sale at the Spring Conference and the Summer Convention. There have been a number of tickets sold that will be converted to the raffle tickets prior to the drawing.

b. Flag Pole: A number of tickets have been sold already, and tickets will continue to be sold at the conference and summer convention.

3. Appreciation goes out to the faithful, daily work being done by Janis Beal on transmittals, and to the Senior Vice-Commandant and Adjutant for their work on the fund raising efforts.
